20 SEPTEMBER: Arrival & accommodation

21 SEPTEMBER: OPEN YOUR EYES- PUBBLIC EVENT (c/o Ex – Cinema Capitol)

MORNING: Official opening with Public Administration. A video will open the meeting.

AFTERNOON: Each country will give his support for team building games .Well accepted verbal and not verbal games and workshops for acquiring and/ or foster ability to communicate in a multicultural environment.

EVENING: INTERCULTURAL DINNER WHAT WE ASK: whatever you want us to taste! Do not forget music!

22 SEPTEMBER: THE TRIP

MORNING: I simulation activity - The participants will walk till Vesuvius Vulcan (14,4 km) so to push them to think later (during the workshop) on the efforts that a migrant does when decide to leave his own country for hoping to get a better life (learning by doing methodology)

AFTERNOON: meeting with young migrants at care home. The participants will compare their own experience with whom choose to do it at any price. Workshop : “Can I come in?” from Compass

23 SEPTEMBER: COMMUNICATION

MORNING: II simulation activity – Italian educators give an Italian language lesson to Meda participants while some of Meda Youth leaders give Arabic language lesson to European groups. Learning the new language is one of mandatory step that each migrant has to do for his social inclusion in a new country. This is a preparation for the simulation activity “Searching”

AFTERNOON: People and countries – what we can do, what we cannot do in our country; habits/customs and traditions. Let’s start to build our social guide

EVENING: Dinner in an Italian family

24 SEPTEMBER: SEARCHING

MORNING: The planned activities are strictly related to the process of social integration of migrants and related to job search , health care and documents request for the integration in the municipality of Portici. A goal will be assigned to each participant such as to find a job or to work in a local shop, meeting with employees at local administration (for requesting necessary documents to the residence permit etc); demand for health care at the territorial ASL etc

AFTERNOON: FREE TIME

25 SEPTEMBER: SOCIAL GUIDE WORLD CAFE’

Feedback about the experience in the Italian family and meeting with migrants to compare the experiences about “Searching” simulation activity.

Building our social guide: collecting information about the associations and contacts for practical help to those who want to move in the country involved for work, study, volunteer on long or medium term. The participants will also become promoters of this idea and they will try to involve other associations who want to join the guide and its social aims for young people.
